WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management-Bids and Awards Committee (DBM-BAC) conducted Public Bidding for the Project, "Courier Services," with an Approved Budget for the Contract of P7,000,000.00 for FYs 2021 and 2022, through the authorized appropriations under the FY 2021 General Appropriations Act and Multi-Year Contractual Authority No. MYCA-BMB-C-19-0000005, as reflected in the Annual Procurement Plan, CY 2021;

WHEREAS, as part of DBM's early procurement activities, the Invitations to Bid for the Project were posted on the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) website, the DBM website, and all DBM bulletin boards on October 27, 2020 and November 20, 2020, but failures of bidding were declared on November 17, 2020 under BAC Resolution No. 2020-52 and on December 11, 2020 under BAC Resolution No. 2020-63, respectively;

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2021, the third Invitation to Bid was posted on the PhilGEPS website, the DBM website, and all DBM bulletin boards;

WHEREAS, two (2) prospective bidders, namely: (i) Airspeed Philippines; and (ii) Premier Logistics, Inc., responded to the said Invitation and attended the Pre-bid Conference via videoconferencing on January 19, 2021;

WHEREAS, Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 1 was issued on January 26, 2021 to clarify, modify or amend items in the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, during the submission and opening of bids on February 2, 2021, only one bidder, Intertraffic Transport Corporation (Intertraffic), submitted a bid;

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2021, after preliminary examination of the bid, the DBM-BAC, using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria, determined the submission of Intertraffic as "passed" for complying with all the eligibility and technical requirements as stated in the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, after evaluation of the financial proposal of Intertraffic, the BAC declared the submission of Intertraffic as the Single Calculated Bid in the amount of P6,486,940.00;

WHEREAS, after careful examination, validation and verification, the DBM-BAC determined that the eligibility, technical and financial components of the bid of Intertraffic have passed all the criteria for post-qualification;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the DBM-BAC RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVED, the following:

- To declare the bid of Intertraffic Transport Corporation for the Project, "Courier Services," in the amount of P6,486,940.00 as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid, in accordance with Section 36 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184; and
- 2) To recommend to the Secretary of the Department of Budget and Management, as the Head of the Procuring Entity, that the contract for the Project be awarded to Intertraffic Transport Corporation in the abovementioned amount, in accordance with Section 36, in relation to Section 34.4, of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

1. Scope of Contract

This Contract shall include all such items, although not specifically mentioned, that can be reasonably inferred as being required for its completion as if such items were expressly mentioned herein. All the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR, including the Generic Procurement Manual, and associated issuances, constitute the primary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract, and thus, applicable in contract implementation. Herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract.

This is without prejudice to Sections 74.1 and 74.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184 allowing the GPPB to amend the IRR, which shall be applied to all procurement activities, the advertisement, posting, or invitation of which were issued after the effectivity of the said amendment.

Additional requirements for the completion of this Contract shall be provided in the **Special Conditions of Contract (SCC).**

2. Advance Payment and Terms of Payment

- 2.1. Advance payment of the contract amount is provided under Annex "D" of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 2.2. The Procuring Entity is allowed to determine the terms of payment on the partial or staggered delivery of the Goods procured, provided such partial payment shall correspond to the value of the goods delivered and accepted in accordance with prevailing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The terms of payment are indicated in the SCC.

3. Performance Security

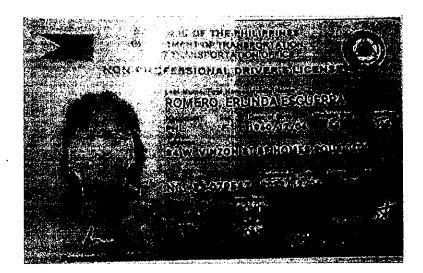
