Resolution No. 2021-29

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management-Bids and Awards Committee (DBM-BAC) conducted Public Bidding for the Project, "Replacement and Repair of Roofing, Repainting of Roof Catwalk, and Waterproofing of Concrete Gutter and Staircase Concrete Cover of DBM Building II," with an Approved Budget for the Contract of P5,500,000.00 through the authorized appropriations under the FY 2021 General Appropriations Act, as reflected in the CY 2021 Annual Procurement Plan;

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2021, the Invitation to Bid for the Project was posted on the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) website, the DBM website, and all DBM bulletin boards;

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2021, after preliminary examination of the bids, the DBM-BAC, using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria, determined the submissions of Interworld Enterprises (Interworld), Thaumaturgy Trade Philippines (Thaumaturgy), EEC Coating, Waterproofing and General Services, Inc. (EEC), My Dreamhome Builder, Inc. (My Dreamhome), and ITC Corporation (ITC) as "passed" for complying with all the eligibility and technical requirements as stated in the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, after evaluation of the financial components of the bids determined as "passed," the bidders were ranked according to their bid submissions, as follows:

1. My Dreamhome - P4,668,000.00

2. Thaumaturgy - P4,703,298.18 (as recalculated)

3. ITC - P4,888,888.88 4. EEC - P4,899,372.52 5. Interworld - P4,988,000.00

WHEREAS, the DBM-BAC accordingly declared the submission of My Dreamhome as the Lowest Calculated Bid in the amount of P4,668,000.00;

WHEREAS, after verification, validation, and ascertainment of all statements made and documents submitted by My Dreamhome, using non-discretionary criteria, as stated in the Bidding Documents, it was determined that the submission of My Dreamhome is inconsistent with the prescribed contents of the Bidding Documents, particularly Section VII. Technical Specifications;

WHEREAS, under BAC Resolution No. 2021-26 dated April 27, 2021, the DBM-BAC resolved as follows:

 To declare the post-disqualification of My Dreamhome for the Project, "Replacement and Repair of Roofing, Repainting of Roof Catwalk, and Waterproofing of Concrete Gutter and Staircase Concrete Cover of DBM Building II," and to notify the said bidder in writing about its post-disqualification and the grounds for it, pursuant to Section 34.5 of the of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184; and

 To initiate and complete the post-qualification process on the bidder with the second Lowest Calculated Bid, Thaumaturgy, pursuant to Section 34.6 of same IRR;

WHEREAS, the DBM-BAC issued the Notice of Post-disqualification to My Dreamhome on April 28, 2021;¹

WHEREAS, Section 55.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184 provides, among others, that "[d]ecisions of the BAC at any stage of the procurement process may be questioned by filing a request for reconsideration within the three (3) calendar days upon receipt of written notice or upon verbal notification." (emphasis supplied);

WHEREAS, through letter dated April 28, 2021,² My Dreamhome sought reconsideration of the DBM-BAC's declaration of its submission as "post-disqualified." It emphasized that, "as per our understanding we compl[ied with] the prescribe[d] Technical Specification[s] for the Repainting of DBM Building II Roof Catwalk as prescribed in the bidding documents. For this we want to justify that what you stated [in] your letter we mark[ed] 'comply' to the given scope of works and technical specification[s] as per required";

WHEREAS, the DBM-BAC, in its letter-reply dated April 30, 2021³ to My Dreamhome, explained, among others, that Section VII. Technical Specifications of the Bidding Documents submitted by My Dreamhome failed to include the statement, "All works shall be done in accordance with standard engineering procedures and workmanship," as part of Item No. II.1.d, as prescribed in the Bidding Documents. Such missing statement is even evident in the copy of the Technical Specifications appended by My Dreamhome in its request for reconsideration. Further, it was disclosed that, in a similar subject matter, the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) in Non-Policy Matter (NPM) No. 040-2012, opined, among others, that "[D]uring the post-qualification stage of the bidding process. the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) determines the responsiveness of the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) against the requirements specified in the Bidding Documents. In case the BAC finds that the LCB does not comply with the requirements specified in the Bidding Documents using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion, it shall notify the bidder of its Hence, the DBM-BAC denied the request for reconsideration of My disqualification". Dreamhome, and affirmed its declaration finding My Dreamhome as "post-disqualified":

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 55 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184, My Dreamhome has seven (7) calendar days upon receipt of the DBM-BAC letter on May 1, 2021, or until May 8, 2021, to protest the DBM-BAC's decision by filing a verified position paper, accompanied by the payment of a non-refundable protest fee, before the Head of the Procuring Entity;

WHEREAS, Section 57 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184 provides that, "[i]n no case shall any protest taken from any decision treated in this Rule stay or delay the bidding process: Provided, however, That protests must first be resolved before any award is made";

WHEREAS, upon verification with the DBM Central Records Division on May 10, 2021, it was determined that, as of said date, no protest from My Dreamhome was received on the DBM-BAC's denial of its request for reconsideration;

WHEREAS, Section 34.6 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184 provides that "[i]mmediately after the BAC has notified the first bidder of its post-disqualification, and notwithstanding any pending request for reconsideration thereof, the BAC shall initiate and complete the same post-qualification process on the bidder with the second Lowest Calculated Bid/Highest Rated Bid. **If the second bidder passes the post-qualification, and provided that the request for reconsideration of the first bidder has been denied**, the second bidder shall be post-qualified as the bidder with the LCRB or HRRB." (emphasis supplied);

WHEREAS, considering the foregoing and pursuant BAC Resolution No. 2021-26, after verification, validation, and ascertainment of all statements made and documents submitted by Thaumaturgy, using non-discretionary criteria, as stated in the Bidding Documents, the DBM-BAC found that the submission of Thaumaturgy passed all the criteria for post-qualification.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the DBM-BAC **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, the following:

- 1. To declare the bid of Thaumaturgy Trade Philippines for the Project, "Replacement and Repair of Roofing, Repainting of Roof Catwalk, and Waterproofing of Concrete Gutter and Staircase Concrete Cover of DBM Building II," in the amount of P4,703,298.18 as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid, in accordance with Section 34.6 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184;
- 2. To recommend to the DBM Secretary, as the Head of the Procuring Entity, that the contract for the Project be awarded to Thaumaturgy Trade Philippines in the above-mentioned amount, in accordance with Section 37.1.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184; and
- To notify all other bidders, in writing, of the DBM-BAC's recommendation within three (3) calendar days from the issuance of the resolution recommending award of the contract, pursuant to Section 37.1.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

1. Scope of Contract

This Contract shall include all such items, although not specifically mentioned, that can be reasonably inferred as being required for its completion as if such items were expressly mentioned herein. All the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR, including the Generic Procurement Manual, and associated issuances, constitute the primary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract, and thus, applicable in contract implementation. Herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract.

This is without prejudice to Sections 74.1 and 74.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184 allowing the GPPB to amend the IRR, which shall be applied to all procurement activities, the advertisement, posting, or invitation of which were issued after the effectivity of the said amendment.

Additional requirements for the completion of this Contract shall be provided in the **Special Conditions of Contract (SCC).**

2. Advance Payment and Terms of Payment

- 2.1. Advance payment of the contract amount is provided under Annex "D" of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 2.2. The Procuring Entity is allowed to determine the terms of payment on the partial or staggered delivery of the Goods procured, provided such partial payment shall correspond to the value of the goods delivered and accepted in accordance with prevailing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The terms of payment are indicated in the **SCC**.

3. Performance Security

Within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award by the Bidder from the Procuring Entity but in no case later than prior to the signing of the Contract by both parties, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security in any of the forms prescribed in Section 39 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

4. Inspection and Tests

5. Warranty

- 5.1 In order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the Supplier, a warranty shall be required from the Supplier as provided under Section 62.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 5.2 The Procuring Entity shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty. Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof without cost to the Procuring Entity, pursuant to the Generic Procurement Manual.

6. Liability of the Supplier

The Supplier's liability under this Contract shall be as provided by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.
