**WHEREAS**, the Department of Budget and Management-Bids and Awards Committee (DBM-BAC) conducted a Public Bidding for the Project, "Renewal of Licenses for the Subscription of AZURE FortiGate-VM," with an Approved Budget for the Contract of P1,700,000.00 through the authorized appropriations under the FY 2021 General Appropriations Act, as reflected in the CY 2021 Annual Procurement Plan;

**WHEREAS**, on May 18, 2021, the Invitation to Bid for the Project was posted on the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) website, the DBM website, and all DBM bulletin boards;

**WHEREAS**, only one (1) prospective bidder, Accent Micro Technologies, Inc. (AMTI), responded to the said Invitation and attended the Pre-bid Conference via videoconferencing on May 25, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, during the submission and opening of bids on June 8, 2021, only one (1) bidder, AMTI, submitted a bid;

**WHEREAS**, after preliminary examination of the bid, the DBM-BAC, using nondiscretionary "pass/fail" criteria, determined the submission of AMTI as "passed" for complying with all the eligibility and technical requirements as stated in the Bidding Documents;

**WHEREAS**, after evaluation of the financial component of the bid, the DBM-BAC declared the submission of AMTI as the Single Calculated Bid in the amount of P1,650,000.00;

**WHEREAS**, after verification, validation, and ascertainment of all statements made and documents submitted by AMTI, using non-discretionary criteria, as stated in the Bidding Documents, it was determined that the submission of AMTI passed all the criteria for postqualification.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the DBM-BAC **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, the following:

1. To declare the bid of Accent Micro Technologies, Inc. for the Project, "Renewal of Licenses for the Subscription of AZURE FortiGate-VM," in the amount of P1,650,000.00 as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid, in accordance with Section 34.4 in relation to Section 36 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184; and

2. To recommend to the DBM Secretary, as the Head of the Procuring Entity, that the contract for the Project be awarded to Accent Micro Technologies, Inc. in the above-mentioned amount, in accordance with Section 37.1.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.



### 2.0 OBJECTIVE

To have a Firewall for Microsoft Azure with the flexibility to deploy as next-generation firewall and VPN Gateway with compatibility to the existing DBM Fortinet Firewall to have complete network protection with a comprehensive suite of security features that will protect DBM cloud-based applications and infrastructure against known cybersecurity threats and newly emerging threats.

### **3.0 SUBCRIPTION PERIOD**

The subscription period for the Renewal of Licenses for the Subscription of AZURE FortiGate-VM shall be for twelve (12) months (i.e., December 6, 2021 - December 5, 2022).

**5.4** A Certificate of Acceptance shall be issued by the Director of Information and Communications Technology Systems Service (ICTSS) once all the requirements are fully met by the CONTRACTOR.



### 6.0 SERVICE LEVEL AGREEMENT

DBM shall maintain a Service Level Agreement (SLA) with the CONTRACTOR, with provisions for liquidated damages for their non-compliance.

### 7.0 WARRANTIES OF THE CONTRACTOR

- **7.1** The CONTRACTOR warrants that it shall conform strictly to the terms and conditions of this technical specifications.
- **7.2** The CONTRACTOR warrants the reliability of the services and their manpower complement. The CONTRACTOR further warrants that the technical staff assigned are qualified to provide the service required to the satisfaction of the DBM.

The CONTRACTOR's personnel shall coordinate with the authorized and/or designated DBM ICTSS personnel in the performance of their jobs.

- **7.3** The CONTRACTOR shall neither assign, transfer, pledge, nor subcontract any part or interest to the contract being bidded out.
- **7.4** The CONTRACTOR shall identify the technical support personnel that will be given authority to access and operate the AZURE FortiGate-VM. The DBM shall be informed through a formal notice of the change or replacement of technical personnel five (5) days before the actual rendering of technical support services.

**7.5** The CONTRACTOR shall provide a one (1)-year subscription which shall include technical support and assistance which shall be covered by special bank guarantee equivalent to 10% of the total contract price. The said amount shall be released after the lapse of the warranty period. Provided, further, that the goods supplied are free from patent and latent defect and all conditions imposed under the contract have been fully met.

The subscription shall commence on December 6, 2021.

### 8.0 CONFIDENTIALITY OF DATA

- **8.1** All project personnel of the CONTRACTOR shall be required to sign a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA).
- **8.2** The DBM Enterprise Network System, its component, parts and all products, products samples and specifications, data, ideas, technology, and technical/non-technical materials, all or any which may be derived from any of the foregoing are confidential.
- **8.3** The CONTRACTOR agrees to hold all the foregoing information in strict confidence. The CONTRACTOR further agrees not to reproduce or disclose any confidential information to 3rd parties without the prior written approval of the DBM.

### 9.0 TERMS OF PAYMENT

- **9.1** The CONTRACTOR shall be paid a one-time payment for the Renewal of Licenses for the Subscription of AZURE FortiGate-VM upon completion of project implementation as specified in SECTION V of the technical specification subject to the required Final Withholding VAT (Services) of five percent (5%) and Expanded Withholding Tax of two percent (2%).
- **9.2** Payment shall be made within a reasonable time from the submission of the documentary requirements such as but not limited to the following, based on existing accounting and auditing laws, rules and regulations:
  - 9.2.1 Statement of Account/ Billing Invoice/ Sales Invoice.
  - 9.2.2 Certificate of Acceptance issued by the ICTSS Director
  - 9.2.3 Non-Disclosure Agreement

No advance payment shall be made as provided for in Section 88 of Presidential Decree (PD) No. 1445 (Government Auditing Code of the Philippines).

### **10.0 PRE-TERMINATION OF CONTRACT**



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

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

Section IV. General Conditions of Contract

### **1.** Scope of Contract

This Contract shall include all such items, although not specifically mentioned, that can be reasonably inferred as being required for its completion as if such items were expressly mentioned herein. All the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR, including the Generic Procurement Manual, and associated issuances, constitute the primary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract, and thus, applicable in contract implementation. Herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract.

This is without prejudice to Sections 74.1 and 74.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184 allowing the GPPB to amend the IRR, which shall be applied to all procurement activities, the advertisement, posting, or invitation of which were issued after the effectivity of the said amendment.

Additional requirements for the completion of this Contract shall be provided in the **Special Conditions of Contract (SCC).** 

### 2. Advance Payment and Terms of Payment

- 2.1. Advance payment of the contract amount is provided under Annex "D" of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 2.2. The Procuring Entity is allowed to determine the terms of payment on the partial or staggered delivery of the Goods procured, provided such partial payment shall correspond to the value of the goods delivered and accepted in accordance with prevailing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The terms of payment are indicated in the **SCC**.

### **3. Performance Security**

Within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award by the Bidder from the Procuring Entity but in no case later than prior to the signing of the Contract by both parties, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security in any of the forms prescribed in Section 39 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

### 4. Inspection and Tests

The Procuring Entity or its representative shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goods to confirm their conformity to the Project specifications at no extra cost to the Procuring Entity in accordance with the Generic Procurement Manual. In addition to tests in the **SCC**, **Section IV (Technical Specifications)** shall specify what inspections and/or tests the Procuring Entity requires, and where they are to be conducted. The Procuring Entity shall notify the Supplier in writing, in a timely manner, of the identity of any representatives retained for these purposes.

All reasonable facilities and assistance for the inspection and testing of Goods, including access to drawings and production data, shall be provided by the Supplier to the authorized inspectors at no charge to the Procuring Entity.

### 5. Warranty

- 5.1 In order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the Supplier, a warranty shall be required from the Supplier as provided under Section 62.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 5.2 The Procuring Entity shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty. Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof without cost to the Procuring Entity, pursuant to the Generic Procurement Manual.

### 6. Liability of the Supplier

The Supplier's liability under this Contract shall be as provided by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

If the Supplier is a joint venture, all partners to the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable to the Procuring Entity.
