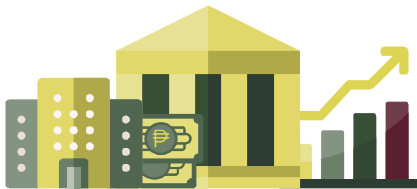

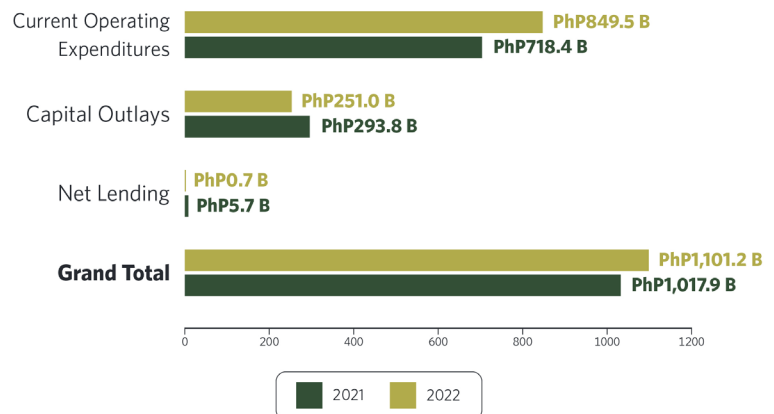


The Philippine government recorded a spending of

## Major Expenditures

Subsidies for housing projects

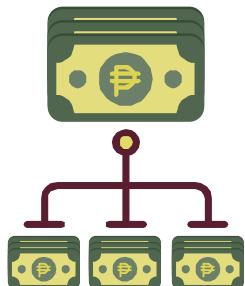

## NCA and Non-NCA Disbursements



NCA expenditures increased to PhP847.5 billion, 11.2% higher than the PhP762.1 billion recorded in 2021, mostly due to higher transfers to local government units through the National Tax Allotment.

Non-NCA expenditures amounted to PhP253.7 billion, 0.8% lower than the previous year's, due to lower encashment of check floats or the payments wherein checks have been issued in the previous year but were only encashed in the current year.



## What is a Notice of Cash Allocation (NCA)?

Cash authority issued by the Department of Budget and Management to the account of agencies/operating units through the authorized MDS-GSBs, to cover the cash requirements of the agencies.

## What is a Non-NCA Disbursement?

Budgetary accounts which are paid without requiring the issuance of Notices of Cash Allocation (NCAs) during the budget year in consideration. Other disbursement authority documents are Cash Disbursement Ceiling and Notice of Cash Allocation.
