

6.4% 2024-3rd Quarter: Php 1,499.7 B
2023-3rd Quarter: Php 1,409.4 B

In the third quarter of 2024, National Government (NG) disbursements reached Php 1,499.7 billion, marking a 6.4% increase from Php 1,409.4 billion in the same period last year. This growth highlights the government's sustained spending efforts, supported by a notable 16.9% rise in revenues, which helped narrow the deficit to Php 356.3 billion-from Php 431.8 billion for the comparable period in 2023.

NG Fiscal Performance (2024 vs. 2023)




