- 1. Trust Receipts for the Human Rights Violations Victims' Memorial Commission. The amount of Three Hundred Sixteen Nillion Fifty Bine Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty Mine Pesos and Eighty Three Centavos (P316,059,829.83) as certified by the Bureau of the Treasury on Hay 20, 2016 representing accrued interest on the Ten Billion Pesos (P10,000,000,000) fund of the HRVCB for the period 27 March 2014 to 31 Harch 2016, shall be used for the establishment, restoration, preservation and conservation of the memorial, museum, library and compandium in honor of the human rights violation victims during the Marcos regime in accordance with Section 27 of R.A. No. 10368. Said amount shall be deposited with the National Treasury and recorded as trust receipts in accordance with E.O. No. 338, s. 1996.
- 2. Reporting and Posting Requirements. The Human Rights Violations Victims' Hemorial Commission (HRYVMC) shall submit quarterly reports on its financial and physical accomplishments, within thirty (30) days after the end of every quarter, through the following:
