**TO :** All Heads of Departments, Agencies, State Universities and Colleges, Government-Owned and/or Controlled Corporations receiving Budgetary Support from the National Government; Heads of Budget and Accounting Units and All Others Concerned

**SUBJECT :** WEBSITE FOR THE UNIFIED ACCOUNTS CODE STRUCTURE (UACS)

- 1.0 COA-DBM-DOF Joint Circular No. 2013-1 dated August 6, 2013 provides for the Adoption of the Unified Accounts Code Structure (UACS) for the national government's financial transactions pertaining to budget preparation, legislation, execution and accountability, effective January 1, 2014, and COA-DBM-DOF Joint Circular No. 2014-1 dated November 7, 2014 provides for the adoption/implementation of the enhanced UACS structure.
- 2.0 For easy reference on the UACS, the DBM has launched the UACS Website that provides users with the ability to view, search, and download the latest UACS Codes by accessing the Uniform Resource Locator (URL) <http://www.uacs.gov.ph/>.
- 3.0 To ensure that UACS users have sufficient reference materials to be used in the budget preparation, execution, and accountability, including recording and reporting of all financial transactions of the national government agencies, all reference materials pertaining to the UACS are available and can be downloaded from the UACS website.
