


Legal Basis

- Commonwealth Act No. 591 (August 19, 1940) created the National Statistics Office (NSO) as the Bureau of Census and Statistics (BCS).
- Executive Order No. 314 (January 1, 1941) transferred to the BCS the powers and functions of other statistical agencies such as the Division of Labor Statistics (Department of Labor) and the Vital Statistics Section of the Bureau of Health (Department of Instruction).
- **Presidential Decree No. 418** (March 20, 1974) reconstituted the BCS into the National Census and Statistics Office (NCSO) under the administrative supervision of the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA).
- Executive Order No. 121 (January 30, 1987), "Reorganizing and Strengthening the Philippine Statistical System and for Other Purposes", renamed the NCSO to National Statistics Office (NSO) and placed it under the administrative supervision of the Office of the President.
- Executive Order No. 149 (December 28, 1993) transferred back the NSO to NEDA, placing it under NEDA's administrative supervision for effective policy and program coordination and integration.
- Executive Order No. 5 (October 23, 1999) mandated the "Strengthening of the National Statistics Office" through decentralization of statistics generation activities, transformation of Central Office units into more developmental planning and evaluation units, and increased application of information technology in its operations.

Mandate

The National Statistics Office (NSO) is responsible for collecting, compiling, classifying, producing, publishing and disseminating general-purpose statistics and for carrying out and administering the provisions of the Civil Registry Law.




